

Active Wear Day

As part of National Walking Month Becket Primary School held an Active Wear Day on Tuesday 7th May 2024.

The aim of the day was to encourage active travel to school. Children wore tracksuits, trainers, football kits and t-shirts so they were dressed for activity and encouraged to use walking as their method of travel to and from school. We held an assembly in the week leading up to this sharing the importance of walking as part of a healthy lifestyle and finding out about walks in North Somerset that we could do with our families. On this day 84% of children used an active means of travel, compared to an average of 75% of children using an active means of travel across the year so far.

We still have lots to look forward to during National Walking Month and will be continuing to promote active travel during Walk to School Week (20th -24th May 2024).
